


WALK 2 Exploring Cerne Abbas



Cerne Abbas viewing area car park DT2 7AL / GRID REF: ST663016
2.5 miles / 1-2 hours

1. From car park walk down the lane towards the village.
2. Turn left along another lane, past the village hall on right and additional Kettle Bridge car park & picnic area on left.
3. Turn left in front of the stone barn then right, following Giant Walks signs.
4. Go through the kissing gate in the woods, and at the sign-post turn left up the steps to Giant Hill.
5. Follow this path for 3/4 mile, along the base of the Giant enclosure, gradually gaining height before turning sharply up hill.
6. At the top, do not cross the stile, but follow the Giant Walk sign, or pick your own path, across the top of the hill back to the top of the Giant enclosure.
7. Head down the steep hill, keeping the enclosure fence on your right until you meet the track leading back to the steps and kissing gate in the woods. Here you can go back to the car park or take the gentle walk into Cerne Abbas village for shop, pubs and café.
